The Canton Local Board of Education met in Regular Session on June 12, 2017 at 7:00 PM at the Canton Local Administrative Offices. All members were present.

- C. Then and Now certification for PO#88348 in the amount of \$3,020.00 to Fan Cloth.
- D. Contract with J. Eslich Construction & Equipment Corp. in the amount of \$795,200.00 for the abatement and demolition of the old Canton South High School. J. Eslich was the lowest bidder at the bid opening held May 23, 2017. Seven qualifying bids were received for the project.
- E. Resolution establishing the 070 Capital Projects Fund for the purpose of accumulating resources for the acquisition, construction or improvement of fixed assets and the initial transfer of \$2,900,000.00 from the General Fund into the Capital Projects Fund.

Under communications, Reno Contipelli from the Ohio School Boards Association presented 20 year service awards to Scott Hamilton and David Brothers for 20 years of service as members of the Canton Local Board of Education. Christine Scarpino announced the 2017-18 Student Representatives to the Board, Mckenzie Rush and Andrew Ricketts. Under Facilities, Scott Hamilton indicated that the interior of the building is 99% complete with just a few inspections still required prior to occupancy.

Superintendent Steve Milano recognized the High School custodians for their hard work and dedication in moving materials from the old High School into the new High School. The New High School dedication and open house will take place August 12th from 1-5 PM. For Career Tech, 12 students earned Certified Welder credentials, 18 graduating seniors in Auto, Welding and Culinary Arts were employed through early placement, over 150 free college credit hours were earned by students in CTE programs. For the High School, graduation was held at the Palace Theatre on May 30th with 132 graduates accepting their diplomas. Special guests at the event were sisters Hazel, Irene and Ruth Jarrell. Hazel Jarrell was a member of the first graduating class of Canton Township High in 1932. Irene Jarrell was a member of the Class of 1933 and Ruth Jarrell Gerber was a member of the Class of 1935.
