

The following items are current suicide prevention and intervention supports that have been put in place to help students and staff members in the CLSD.

- Extensive counseling services for students and staff members
- The implementation of national, evidence-based prevention programs for all staff members to help them recognize the warning signs to keep kids safe:
 - Canton South High School Signs of Suicide Program
 - Faircrest Middle School
 Signs of Suicide Program and The
 Jason Foundation, INC. online Staff
 Development Training Modules
 - Walker Elementary School Sandy Hook Promise: Know the Signs and Start with Hello Programs
- The establishment of crisis teams at each building, as well as a district crisis team
- The presence of teachers in the hallways at all buildings during class change

- The implementation of anti-bullying programs at every building level to support our district's zero tolerance policy
- The follow-up to concerns brought to the district's attention
- The availability of school counselors and staff to students during school hours - students are encouraged and welcomed to contact the police department or crisis team after school hours
- The addition of licensed personnel from CommQuest Recovery, Counseling and Support
- Contracted with Stark County Mental Health & Addiction Recovery (StarkMAR) to utilize additional clinical counselors and support personnel as needed
