These "Title I" funds allow us to service identified students in grades kindergarten through grade four.

Your child has been identified as being eligible for these services. Recommendations for Title I services have been made for your child by using a combination of results from state achievement test, assessment of your child's oral reading and comprehension, I-Ready Diagnostic Assessment and/or referral from classroom teachers.

Title I services can vary throughout the year. Some of the ways your child might be serviced using Title I funds include:

- One-on-one instruction in or out of the classroom.
- Small group instruction in or out of the classroom.
- A Title I staff member may work with other groups of children so that the classroom teacher can devote more time to your child.
- Intervention programs such as Leveled Literacy Intervention, Fundations, Orton Gillingham and Wilson Reading Program.

All planning is coordinated with the classroom teacher to ensure that all students receive instruction that meets their needs. We encourage you to communicate with our school staff members so that you are aware of the best ways to work with your child at home. We believe that we are a team, working toward the same goal...ensuring that your child becomes a proficient and lifelong reader.
