Thank you to our community members and generous donors! Updates to Brechbuhler Stadium are nearly complete.

The 8.0 mill levy Canton Local voters generously approved in November of 2013 included funds to construct the new entrance, concession stand, visitor locker room, spirit store and restrooms.

The Canton South Stadium Turf fundraising committee set out to raise the funds needed for the synthetic turf and other improvements and upgrades outside of the district's budget that are not funded by community tax dollars. CSHS Water Line Project Update

Taylor Companies of Ohio are on site and working to correct the issues that resulted from the water line break at Canton South High School. Both Taylor Companies and the district's insurance company have been very cooperative in assessing the damages and doing the repair work. The ordering of replacement items has been done through the original suppliers. The school year will start as originally scheduled. Restoration work will not be 100% complete on August 21st due to the lead-time needed to order items, but the district is working to create the best learning environment possible for students. When the restoration work is completed, the building will be as good as the day the new school opened.

No tax dollars are being used for the restoration project.

SchoolGate Guardian



School Security System

The Canton Local School District has a visitor management software system at each of its schools.

School Gate Guardian requires all visitors to present a valid driver's license or other state-issued identification upon arrival at the door. The ID will be scanned and checked against the sexual offender database. Protocol is in place for those who might not have a state-issued ID.

Visitors who have been cleared will receive a printed ID badge that includes their photo and name. The badge is self-expiring, meaning within 12 hours of receipt; a red stop sign will bleed through to the front so the badge cannot be reused.

The process to scan an ID, run the check and print a badge takes about 30 seconds to complete. Staff members have been trained in how to handle a positive match in the system.

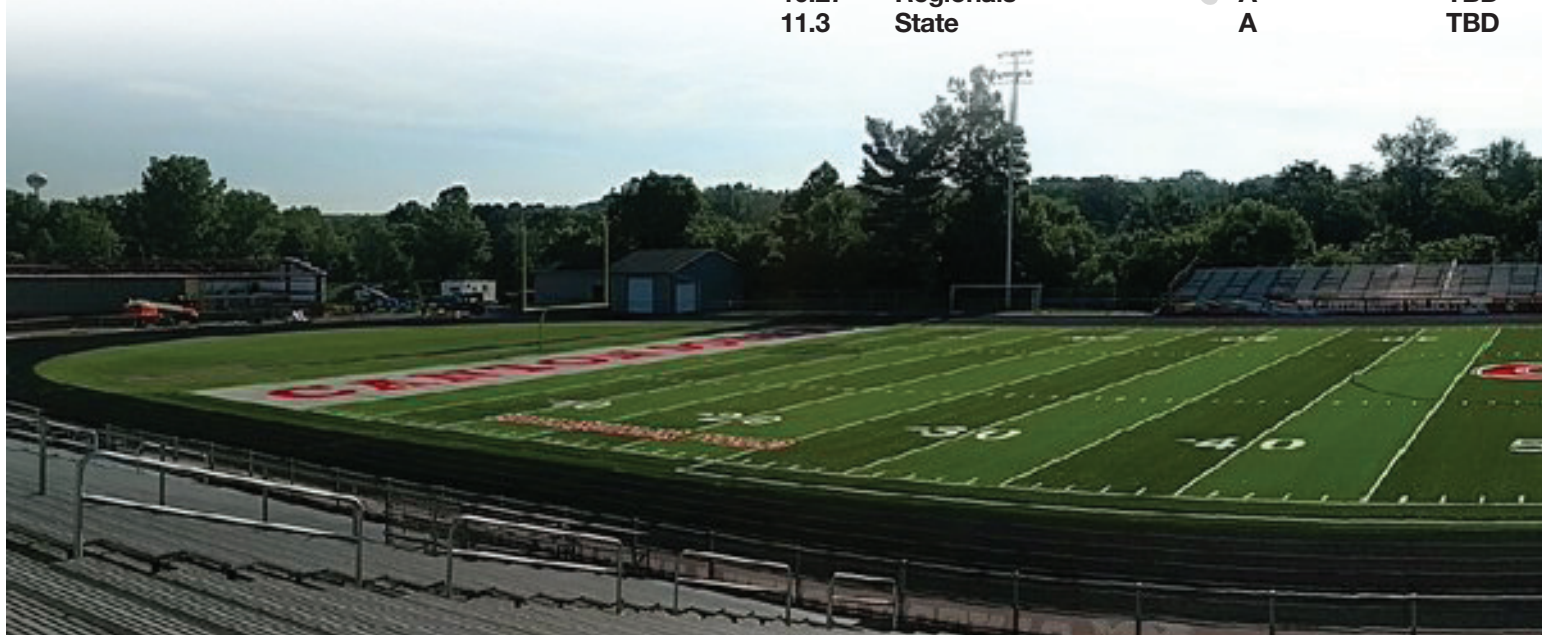

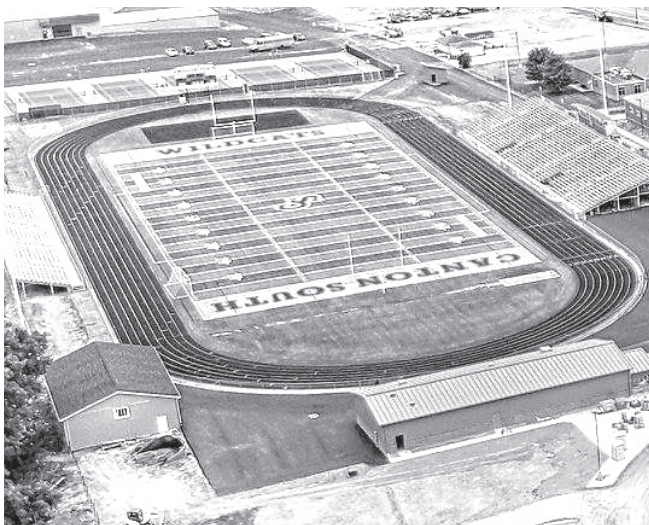
