Remote learning also can include video or audio instruction delivered online or via television, video, telephone or another method that relies on computer or communications technology.*

Attendance is recorded on Mondays (or the first day of the school week) for the previous week's attendance.</p> <p>According to <i>Attendance Considerations for Remote Learning Plans</i> (<a href="http://education.ohio.gov/">http://education.ohio.gov/</a>): "All districts and community schools will be expected to continue reporting attendance in hour increments at the student level within EMIS and should strive for a consistent policy for determining attendance across schools and classrooms within the district."</p> <p><u>Tracking Attendance</u> Attendance may include, but is not limited to, student attendance in virtual online lessons. Attendance may also include, but is not limited to, student participation in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Daily logins to learning management systems;</li><li>• Weekly interactions with teachers to acknowledge attendance;</li><li>• Assignment completion; and</li><li>• Assessment completion.</li></ul> <p>According to <i>Attendance Considerations for Remote Learning Plans</i> (<a href="http://education.ohio.gov/">http://education.ohio.gov/</a>), "If there is no evidence the student participated or engaged in any way in a remote learning activity, then the student should be marked with an absence for the hours for that remote learning activity."</p> <p><u>Tracking Absences</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Excused absences: Any circumstances for which an excuse is received shall be recorded according to the policies set forth in this district handbook.</li><li>• No evidence: If there is no evidence the students participated or engaged in any way in a district-ordered Remote Learning or family-elected Canton Local Virtual Academy activity, then the student shall be marked with an absence for the hours assigned to that activity.</li><li>• Consideration may be made for unique circumstances that are communicated to building principals in a timely manner.</li></ul> <p>Attendance can be viewed in the Home Access Center.</p> <p>NOTE: HB 410 applies to student attendance during district-ordered Remote Learning and family-elected Canton Local Virtual Academy.
